

What: Kuskanax Mountain Trail Maintenance Work Bee

When: Sunday, August 14

Work Bee Meet: 8 am

Location: Vicki's View road intersection with the Hot Spring Road N50.269188 W117.783675

Direction: Two-way return to Second Lookout and back

Carpool: From Hot Springs Road to the Trailhead in private 4x4s (steep rough sections and limited parking at trailhead)

What to Bring: Lunch, lots of water, appropriate clothing, boots and work gloves

The Kuskanax trail received some maintenance by a trail crew this spring on the lower bench section and approximately 450 meters of trail was improved. Although there is still improvement work to be completed at a future date, the trail is in need of general maintenance.

A work bee is needed to spend 4 to 5 hours on the lower section of the trail brushing, raking and grading. This work will be completed with hand tools only, cutting small roots and branches, raking debris and rocks and some shovelling and work with Pulaski's to level uneven section on that trail.

Your attendance and contribution is requested to keep our area trails in safe and accessible condition for our community and visitors and an opportunity to spend the day on this great trail in fellowship with other society members.

The work bee will start at 08:00 am Sunday August 14th at the Kuskanax Mountain Road intersection with the Hot Springs Road. We will carpool from there to limit the number of vehicles traveling up to the trailhead and for those who may not have vehicles capable of the route to the trail head
